The following is the Manager's report regarding activities in the month of January 2016:

Sedona Recycles

Sedona Recycles has been serving the Town of Camp Verde for many years and supplies the community with the recycle bins located near the High School and at Bashas. During that time they have received some level of support annually from the Town of Camp Verde to offset the cost of this service to our community. As a not for profit entity unfortunately they are not receiving the same value for the recycled material that they once were and it is more costly to serve our community bins, which are increasingly used. For now they continue to serve the Town and will do so for the near future, however, through fundraisers, etc. the future of the service is an issue the community will need to face shortly. Thank you to Sedona Recycles for their decision to continue service and the opportunity to work towards a long term stable service. Here is the latest month's report of use:

Completed a Pre-App review and comments on a proposed Circle K store on Finnie Flat Rd. Attended a pre application meeting for a new grow facility on Industrial Dr. Sent letters to three contractors working without permits on two projects and notified the Registrar of Contractors. Revised implemented a new SOP for licensed contractors doing work without permits.

Had a meeting with Public Works, Camp Verde water company, Sanitary staff, Yavapai County environmental and BRLS representatives concerning a grow facility on Hwy 260. Held a meeting with Bureau Veritas consultants. Met with the architect for Kenny construction regarding a new building and staging area on Industrial Dr. Held a second meeting with Public Works, Woodruff construction and Kathy Hellman regarding some addendums to the new library construction.

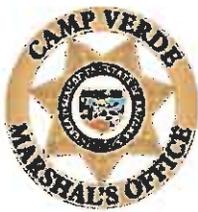

Phoenix courts on Monday will launch a program that could help thousands repay their debts to the city and forge a pathway to reinstating their suspended driver's licenses.

The Compliance Assistance Program is designed to break what can become a crippling cycle of fines and subsequent driving penalties: Unpaid fines can lead to a suspended license. And driving on a suspended license can lead to criminal charges and jail time for the working poor.

As of Dec. 31, Phoenix was owed more than \$283 million in overdue municipal fines, fees and restitution dating back decades. As many as 6,000 people currently have their licenses suspended because of delinquent Phoenix fines.

For many people, unpaid fines are the primary roadblock to the restoration of their driving privileges. Those who qualify for the program will be placed on a realistic payment plan, and court officials in turn will notify the Motor Vehicle Division that participants are compliant with court fines.

"It's really providing a mechanism that people haven't really had before," said B. Don Taylor, chief presiding judge for Phoenix Municipal Court. "I think creating something that will allow them to be compliant, get the license back, really helps them be in a good place."

The initiative comes amid a national discussion on the snowballing effects of municipal fees, which can balloon into thousands of dollars in debt for those unable to pay the initial fines.

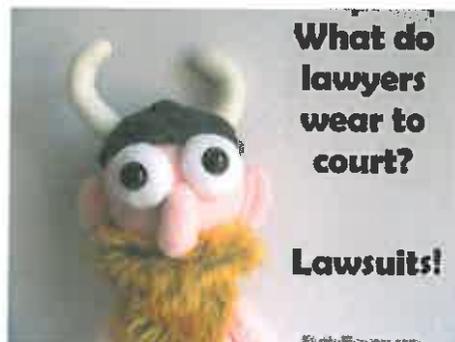
