The following is a general Manager's report regarding activities in the month of July :

Many positive things have been occurring and change is evident throughout the organization and community. As Manager I am very proud of the hard work of staff and the pride they have displayed in our Town is hopefully becoming more obvious to the community at large. A few of the most recent accomplishments include:

Library: They have worked to rearrange some of the limited space they have in hopes of being even more efficient and customer oriented.

Marshal's Office:

New uniforms as well for the VIP's have given this group a boost in pride and energy

Community Development:

Renewed energy in Code Enforcement has taken care some of the long standing problem areas, with more to come.

Courts: Smooth leadership transition and some new staff addressing backlogs and getting to work on lost revenue from unpaid fines, etc.

Clerks: Completing special assignments beyond normal operation that have transformed families lives through HOME replacement and rehabilitation.

Economic Development:

Completion of a possible grant to cover the expenses of the incubator feasibility study as well as working to put Highway 260 back on the table for future economic benefits for Camp Verde and the Verde Valley.

Public Works:

Completion or near completion of so many projects from drainage on Finnie Flat and Verde Lakes Drive to construction along Hollamon with new sidewalks and parking area improvements, not to mention huge strides in the street yard and possibly the most obvious the work around Town Hall so many have complimented on.

Finance: Nearing completion on the printed budget with a refreshed, hopefully even more user friendly version.

I know most of you come through the Town Hall frequently, but if you haven't visited the Library in a while or stopped by the Marshal's office please do, ask questions and take a look around.

The Town is under contract to sell the Horseshoe Bend Home for \$42,000 a closing date has yet to be determined with the funds being put back in the Revolving Loan Fund for a future project. Thanks to Arizona Central Land and Home Realty for helping make this happen.

I have had meetings with the other Managers in the Valley with Mel and her cohorts to discuss the possibility of readdressing Highway 260 as it is in the 5 year plan for limited expansion. During our meetings we were able to discuss other opportunities for cooperation and continue to work on those relationships with the other communities.

Also I had the opportunity to visit the Queen Creek incubator and was very pleased to see the similarities and potential opportunities for success. Queen Creek has grown considerably than when I went there as a kid to visit my Cousin, however I believe the core values of a small western community that for example values their horse property while allowing growth has more similarities than I remembered with our experience here in Camp Verde.

Capital Improvement Process. It is time again to review and update/finish this document we left off in April. I am hoping to work through work sessions / public meetings roughly as follows:

September 26th – Process/Review of projects/Additional projects that need scoped

October 24th – Detailed review of projects proposed (scope, amount, timeline)

November 14th – Review cont'd

December – 12th – Final Draft Discussions

January – Adoption

One final note, the Chamber of Commerce and Archeology Center worked together to transfer the lease on August 1st. The Visitor Center will remain in the building and open as they continue to transition. Remodeling will begin in September with the hope of opening the Center in October.

Monthly Report for July 2012 ~

Business Licenses – We processed 5 new business licenses, 26 renewals, and 2 Special Event vendor permits during the month of June, bringing our total business licenses on file to 582.

Liquor Licenses

We did not process any liquor license application during the month of July.

Special Events

The Clerk's Office worked with Sharon Doran for the July 4th Centennial Celebration sponsored by the American Legion and with Camp Verde Promotions for the Cornfest that was held on July 20 and 21.

Information Requests/Research Hours – We had 15 in-house (Staff & Council) requests for information requiring twelve hours of research time. There were two public requests.

Citizen Complaints – There were no written complaints filed in June.

Customer Assistance – The month of July 2012 averaged 72 customer assistance contacts per day with a total of 1008 phone calls and visitors for the month.

Meetings – There were five Council meetings in July, for which we prepared agendas, agenda packets, minutes, addenda, amendments, Green Sheets, etc. We posted one public notice.

Ordinances and Resolutions – We did not process any Ordinances or Resolutions during the month of July.

Records Management – Other than day-to-day requirements, we have not been able to continue work on this project.

Special Assignments –

CDBG

#100-11 Hollamon Street Improvement Project – Construction is in progress. The grant must be completed and closed out by October 13, 2012.

ADOH HOME Grant

#302-11 Owner-Occupied Housing Rehabilitation Project –

The property owner is in his new home. Please stop by to see the before and after photographs. Council approved the IGA with NACOG at the 8-1 meeting. Additional projects will begin in the next few months.

Training

Virginia and I attended the two-day Elections Training sponsored by the League of Arizona Cities and Towns. There are several new election laws that have a significant impact on the way we conduct municipal elections. The Clerk's office will be bringing some of the new laws to Council for direction.

I also completed the Knowledge Transfer Action Plan (KTAP) required by the ASU School of Public Affairs Master Municipal Clerks' Academy. I am excited to implement the KTAP. Elements of the plan include disaster preparedness, development of a continuation of operations plan for the Clerk's Office, engaged staff, and improved customer service.

Week 1:

- Started going through and organizing files in the director's office and taking mental inventory of available space and assets in current library building and book sale building
- Met with library staff and Peggy via speaker phone to talk about preliminary plans for upcoming changes
- Removed old card catalogs from technical processing room in preparation for putting them in the Town auction
- Deleted several hundred rarely requested books in "storage" status and donated them to the book sale

Week 2:

- Began recruitment for Library Specialist–Cataloging/Technical Services fulltime position to fill the vacancy left by Jan Archull's retirement in February
- Sticks and Tones presented a musical program in the Children's Library room
- Continued consolidating paperwork and space in director's office and removed unneeded shelving in there and in the adult services office
- Deleted all VHS from the collection and consolidated DVDs for easier access by volunteers (VHS donated for sale by the Endowment)
- Reassigned staff workspaces to accommodate Gerry Laurito's new position as Library Specialist and in preparation for new technical services person
- Met with QCI Rep to explore adding a copy/fax/printer machine with attached coin box for patrons to help themselves to these services – considering feasibility/pros&cons
- With Deb Ranney's help, tracked down an old cash register that will streamline cash handling and receipt processes

Week 3:

- Moved desks from director's office into Alice and Gerry's workspace to create a place for Gerry to work and to give Alice a more ergonomically correct work situation
- Painted director's office, moved file cabinets and repurposed an old desk from the book sale storage room to replace the two now being used by Gerry and Alice

- Deleted and recycled hundreds of old magazine issues in preparation for reorganization and utilization of storage spaces
- Moved training workstation from children's office to adult services office
- Additional PC setup by 4D, delivered and installed for Gerry's use
- After Mike Dumas and crew removed small shelving and installed tall shelving from office spaces in the Teen area, reorganized Teen books and area
- Made sure all staff workstations are on the Town network for library staff access to the S: drive
- With Lynda's programming assistance, put a cash register into service in the Library
- Made system changes to affect the following library practices:
 - ✓ added 1 day grace period
 - ✓ removed fine for failure to pickup Hold requests
 - ✓ all material now checks out for 3 weeks at a time
 - ✓ DVDs can now be returned in the book drop without incurring a fine
 - ✓ people temporarily living in the Verde Valley can get a temporary library card without paying a deposit
 - ✓ people requesting a new library card who have no proof of mailing address at time of request are not turned away, but given a TEMP status that allows them limited use of library services until proof is shown and PATRON status is established
 - ✓ teens 16-18 can get a library card at CVCL w/o requiring parent signature for limited access to library material but full access to online services

Week 4:

- Began researching bestseller book leasing plans for adult and teen popular fiction titles
- Mike Dumas and crew changed out the restroom doorknobs for handles that unlock from the inside when the knob is turned so that children will be able to get back out when they lock themselves in
- Library staff started working 4 hours on Fridays (9am – 1pm) to clean out and organize storage spaces in the library in preparation to better utilize available space and resources
- Shelving moves in the Children's Library allowed us to better display the hundreds of Children's easy fiction and nonfiction books
- Began the process of combining collections to reduce the number of categories children's books are separated into (i.e. interfiled Southwest nonfiction with regular nonfiction in the easy readers and teen areas)
- Hosted a library tour for our new SirsiDynix representative (the Library's software vendor) and Yavapai Library Network managers
- Decided to not only reorganize and improve use of space for library materials, but also for library staff and patrons – began reassigning current space by switching the adult services and library director's offices
- Painted former adult services office and removed unneeded shelving
- Renamed all public Internet computers to eliminate confusion for patrons and interruptions to staff

Public Works July 2012

Engineering:

- Met with Chip Norton to discuss possible ideas for trails in Camp Verde
- Met with the Camp Verde Water Company to discuss the water line project to Ca. Hot Woods yard
- Met with the Archaeological Society, new residents of the Visitor Center, to discuss the improvements/changes they will be making to the building
- Met with a business owner on Hollamon to discuss a private project that the owner wants to undertake in conjunction with the Hollamon St. Improvement Project

Streets:

- Met with Judy Adams and Jan Grogan to discuss the Forest Service studies required for the access road to the Community Park and Sanitary District.
- Met with Jacobs and ADOT to discuss the PARA study, outline objectives and dual efforts of ADOT on the SR 260 portion of the study
- Met with NACOG, McDonald Brothers Construction and staff for the pre-construction meeting of Hollamon Street Improvements
- Met with Chris Fetzer of NACOG to discuss SR 260, Industrial Dr. and Goswick Way
- The Streets Crew completed the following tasks as well as responding to an emergency call from the Marshal Office after a storm knocked down a power line and various work orders from the public:
 - completed the first two culverts on Verde Lakes Drive
 - Sprayed the Rights of Way for yellow star thistle on Quarterhorse, Millwood Estates and Verde Lakes area
 - Cleared weeds on approximately 3 miles of road shoulders
 - Processed millings to generate approximately 1,000 tons of material to be used for shoulder repair and upcoming parking lot improvements
 - Processed approximately 275 tons of AB fill material with the Grizzly for upcoming culvert project on Middle Verde Road
 - Work continues on the Public Works Yard – including to the buildings and grounds
 - Repairs and cleanup of roads and rights of way after several storm events

Stormwater:

- Met with a business owner at Outpost Mall to discuss the Finnie Flat Drainage Channel and answer his questions about the project design
- Cleared approximately 24 culverts and 5 miles of open drainage ditches around Town
- Cleaned approximately 8 miles of roadway with sweeper

Maintenance:

- A new metal sign was obtained for Town Hall, it looks terrific; but due to the weigh staff is looking at the best way to hang it
- Installed a new sign at the Ramada, additional painting will be done to the background to enhance the focus on the sign
- Fabricated new gates for the Animal Shelter dog runs
- Began work on the parapet wall on the Public Works office

- Began work to clean up, sheetrock and paint the hallway from the Public Works Conference Room into the gym.
- Prepared the pool, grounds and locker rooms for opening of the pool
- Inspected all playground equipment made some repairs and laid new fall material under the play equipment
- Prepared fields for the opening of softball, and weekly maintenance to all park grounds to keep them watered, mowed and serviced for all activities.
- Work continues on Town grounds with the addition of rock, pathways, and regular maintenance of sprinkler system, mowing trimming and soil enhancements.
- Assisted with Corn Fest to hang banners, prepare the field, provided keys and requests for electric and water.
- The Custodians attended safety training on chemicals and safe work practices
- Repaired water line leak at Town Hall

Parks & Recreation:

- Co-Rec Softball is coming to an end, with the tournament being played the week of July 23rd. Everyone loved the league and is looking forward to playing again next summer.
- Advertisement is out for 3 on 3 Basketball. Due to time restraints and interfering with Grasshopper Basketball, it was decided to host a 3 on 3 League this summer and do a full blown Men's League in the spring.
- Registration forms for Grasshopper Basketball will be going out to the kids just after school starts.
- Staff is assisting with Fourth Fridays and preparing to begin work on Trunk or Treat Main Street in October.
- We have a bus trip November 11, 2012 to the NASCAR Sprint 500. This is something new and we think the tickets will go fast. If you would like to make the trip, tickets are \$72 per person and the seats are located at turn 1.
- An additional bus trip will be planned for September to the Diamondback game.
- Everything is going well at the pool, but it is that time of year when the pool is closed as much as open due to lightning.

Entire Month

Over the entire month of July and the last half of June, the Community Development Director and staff have been providing training to the new Animal Control/Code Enforcement Officers. Training involved review of the Planning & Zoning Ordinances and the Town Code as they relate to Code Enforcement. In addition, an office area with a computer terminal, phone and filing system have been set up for the Code Enforcement Officers in the Community Development Department.

In order to provide an efficient tracking system for the Code Violation complaints, the Community Development Staff created a case tracking log for Nuisance and Zoning Violations respectively. The two (2) tracking logs are housed under the department's shared private folder so that the staff could have immediate access to cases for reference when citizens have questions on a particular case and to help prevent duplicate violation notices from being issued.

By mid-July, the two Code Enforcement officers were completing investigations and sending out Violation Notices. Depending on the notices either being a Nuisance or Zoning Violation, time frames for compliance are set by the Codes. In addition, the Code Enforcement Officer has the option to allow for extensions of time for the citizen out of compliance and is showing a "Good Faith" effort in removing the violation.

There have been numerous violation brought into compliance this month. Some complaints are still active without compliance achieved and there are citizens who have not responded to the notices sent. These citizens will be contacted on, or just after, their expiration date and issued citations by the Code Enforcement Officers. These citations are just like a traffic ticket citing the violator to appear before our Magistrate Judge.

The Community Development Department is presenting the Council with a monthly report of Code Violations that gives the overall numbers that represent an easily understandable overview of the complaints handled for the month.

Mike Jenkins and Jenna Owens met with a developer and the developer's architect to discuss allowed densities and setbacks for a proposed residential Town House environment development. The proposed development is in the central part of the Town and has utilities available with fair access existing. The developer has asked to remain anonymous at this time.

July 26, 2012

- The Community Development Director met with Mr. Tom Palmer from the Prescott National Forest and Mr. Chip Norton with the Verde Front Trails Steering Committee to organize a field trip for the Steering Committee of the trail projects and venues for the Camp Verde area. As you may know, the Steering Committee is made up of appointed employees from the Forest Service, State Land and Parks of the Verde Valley Municipalities, Yavapai County and private organizations. Some of these private organization are as follows; Verde Valley Natural Resource Conservation District and the Friends of the Verde River. The Steering Committee is a sounding board for the local agencies in charge of trail development on their lands throughout the Verde Valley.
- Staff met with the Archeology Group and their contractors and volunteers on the permit requirements for the tenant improvements proposed for the Town owned Visitor's Center building.




