## ORDINANCE 2003-A262

### AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, AMENDING TOWN CODE SECTION 2-3-1 REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING DATES.

**Whereas**, ARS §9-233 requires the Town Council to fix the time and place of regular Council meetings by ordinance; and

**Whereas**, the Town has adopted regular meeting dates for the first and third Wednesdays of the month, with Planning & Zoning matters on the fourth Wednesday, and work sessions as needed on the second Wednesday, as set forth in Section 2-3-1 of the Town Code; and

**Whereas**, the Mayor and Common Council wish to accommodate the public and lessen the impact of lengthy meetings on applicants and citizens; and

**Whereas**, Planning & Zoning issues or general items may be added to any agenda at the Mayor's discretion, if an item is an emergency or will not cause undue public delay,

**NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Camp Verde that Section 2-3-1 of the Town Code is amended as follows:**

Section 1. Section 2-3-1 Regular Meetings, of the Town Code is amended to read:


**Regular Council Meetings.** The Town Council will hold regular meetings at 6:30 p.m. on the first and third Wednesdays at the Town Hall complex on Main Street for general business and public hearings as may be required by law, with the fourth Wednesday set aside for Planning & Zoning matters, and the second Wednesday set aside for work sessions as needed. A work session, in lieu of or in conjunction with a regular meeting, may be called. If a regular meeting or work session is cancelled, such as near a holiday, notice of the cancellation shall be posted. ADDITIONAL ITEMS MAY BE ADDED TO THE COUNCIL HEARS PLANNING & ZONING AGENDA, OR PLANNING AND ZONING ITEMS TO THE REGULAR AGENDA, AT THE MAYOR'S DISCRETION.

Section 2. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, and specifically including Ordinance 2002-A218, adopted by the Town of Camp Verde, in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance or any part of the code adopted herein by reference, are hereby repealed, effective as of the day this ordinance is effective.

Section 3. This ordinance is effective upon completion of publication and any posting as required by law.
