



## **Public Service Announcement**

August 4<sup>th</sup>, 2006

Recently the Town Council adopted the new revised Town Code. One of the major changes affecting the public is Section 10-1-2 Transporting Refuse. It reads as follows:

### **Section 10-1-2 Transporting Refuse**

It is unlawful for any person to transport, or cause to be transported, any refuse on or along any public street or alley within the Town, unless the load is so covered or secured with netting, fabric, or other device so as to prevent any of said load from dropping, sifting, leaking, or otherwise escaping. In the case of timber or bulky items, ropes, straps, cables or chains may be substituted for netting or fabric to provide a securely anchored load.

The revised Town Code will go into affect on September 5, 2006. If this portion of the Code affects you or your business, please make sure all vehicles that are loaded are securely covered by a tarpaulin, canvas, or other cover.
