**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL
OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA,
ESTABLISHING THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE AS THE
"OFFICIAL CENTER OF ARIZONA"**

WHEREAS, The Arizona Professional Land Surveyors (APLS) have passed a resolution calling for the designation as to the geographical center of Arizona; and

WHEREAS, an application is currently in the works with the state's Centennial Committee to designate the designation as an official Arizona 2012 Centennial Legacy Project; and

WHEREAS, The Town is very enthusiastic about being designated as the official "2012 Centennial Closest Community to the Geographic Center of Arizona".

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE
RESOLVE THAT:**

1. To commemorate this event the following Town celebration is planned: Town Hall shall convene to conduct its business and hold a Special Session Council Meeting on February 15, 2012, at the Verde Lakes Clubhouse located at 2867 East Verde Lakes Drive. The clubhouse is the closest facility to the Center Point that has accommodated the Town's Council Meeting/business previously; and
2. On April 1, 2012, a Centennial Legacy Marker will be placed at Rezzonico Park to commemorate Camp Verde as the "Official Center of Arizona".

PASSED AND APPROVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Camp Verde, Arizona, this 15th day of February, 2012.




