

ORDINANCE 2014-A398

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, RELATING TO THE TRANSACTION PRIVILEGE LICENSE TAX; AMENDING THE TAX CODE OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, ARIZONA BY REMOVING EXEMPTION (Q) SALES OF FOOD FOR HOME CONSUMPTION, UNDER SECTION 8-465 RETAIL SALES: EXEMPTIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA:

Section 1: The exemption (q) sales of food for home consumption under section 8-465: Retail sales: exemptions of the Camp Verde Model City Tax Code shall be removed for a three year period commencing upon the effective date of this Ordinance. Sales of food for home consumption shall then be taxable at the current Retail sales tax rate of three percent (3%). The exemption (q), however, shall be reinstated upon that date which is three years after the effective date of this Ordinance, December 1, 2017.

Section 2: The provisions of sections 1 of this ordinance shall be effective from and after December 1, 2014.


