FREE FOURTH FRIDAY KICKS OFF JANUARY 27TH, 5-8 PM

Volunteers from Fort Verde State Park and “Hold the Fort,” the Verde Valley Archaeology Center, Camp Verde Historical Museum, Jail and Hance House, and the Town of Camp Verde have joined efforts to coordinate a monthly community event, held every fourth Friday of the month throughout 2012 in downtown Camp Verde. Admission will be free to each of the venues from 5 to 8 p.m.

The first event will include a presentation and viewing of a private collection of firearms from the 1800’s at Fort Verde, a ceramic identification presentation at the Archaeology Center and a special display at the museum, in addition to hay rides, hot chocolate from a fired kettle, and special menu offered at Sweet Grace Restaurant. Volunteers will stroll along Main Street in period clothing reminiscent of times gone by.

Future Free Fourth Fridays will offer music around the camp fire, a Dutch oven cooking demonstration, digital storytelling, and an exhibit on Native American ceremonial feathers. Summer events will incorporate water activities for kids of all ages.
