Featured Volunteer: Karen Morris

My first library recollections:

Growing up in Kearny, New Jersey, a small town with a big view of the New York City skyline, I was within walking distance of the quaint Branch of the Main Kearny Library that was about two miles away. My childhood library was in a converted Victorian house complete with squeaky wood floors, old wooden bookshelves, and dark corners. I spent many hours in that Branch library excitedly checking out picture books shelf by shelf then reading my way through the BOBBSEY TWINS and NANCY DREW series. The sound of the old check-out machine stamping the due date on the check-out card was music to my ears knowing that was the last step until I could skip home and open my latest treasure. I haven't visited Kearny in years; I looked up the Branch library on line, and it is still there and open for business.

Currently, I enjoy reading historical fiction and debut novels. Just finished I AM PILGRIM by Terry Hayes. After reading several reviews that this is a good summer read, I had to put it on my hold list. Although this is his first novel, Terry Hayes is an accomplished journalist (SYDNEY MORNING HERALD) and screenwriter (MAD MAX 2, DEAD CALM, and others). I AM PILGRIM is an action-packed, thought-provoking page-turner filled with heroes and villains, stories of September 11, a U.S. super agent (the protagonist), Saudi terrorists, jilted lovers, the super wealthy, bio terrorism, and ultimately the triumph of good over evil. Well worth the 600 pages. Earlier this year I read Sue Monk Kidd's THE INVENTION OF WINGS. This novel introduced me to the Grimke sisters, pioneer female abolitionists and women's rights activists from Charlotte, South Carolina. This is a beautifully written, moving story.
