What is SSVF?



Supportive Services for Veteran Families (SSVF) assists low-income Veterans and Veteran families who are homeless or at-risk of homelessness. Priority is given to Veteran families with dependent children, female Veterans, OIF/OEF/OND Veterans and chronically homeless Veterans. Other Veteran groups are served as availability allows. Funding is provided by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs in accordance with their eligibility requirements.

Catholic Charities Community Services is committed to helping Veterans and Veteran families achieve stability through permanent housing. We are proud that many of our SSVF staff Veterans themselves.

Services are*

- Case management
- Housing counseling and search
- Personal financial planning
- Assistance applying for VA and other benefits
- Childcare
- Transportation
- Emergency assistance - eligibility requirements apply
- Referrals for health care, legal, daily living and other services

* Services provided are based on unique need and may not necessarily include financial assistance.

Eligibility requirements:

Veteran or member of a Veteran family: Veteran must have served at least one day active duty in the U.S. Military with any discharge other than dishonorable. A Veteran family is defined as a Veteran individual or multi-person or married household with at least one eligible Veteran.

Homeless or at-risk of homelessness, including imminent threat of eviction.

Household Income less than 50% of the Area Median Income: Defined under Federal guidelines. Income thresholds increase based on family size.

What to bring*:

- Photo ID
- DD Form 214 showing discharge status
- Proof of household income, if any
- Social Security cards for all applicable family members
- Birth certificates of dependent children

* Case managers can assist with missing documentation.
