Notice is hereby given, that the Town of Camp Verde will hold a Special Recall Election to be held on:

**Recall Election: March 8, 2016**

Town Council seat currently held by Council Member Bruce George, whose name must appear on the ballot as a candidate.

**THERE WILL BE NO POLLING PLACES.  
THIS ELECTION WILL BE A 'VOTE BY MAIL' ELECTION.**

It is not necessary to request an early ballot for this election unless you will be out of town the entire 27 day period prior to Election Day.

Official Ballots will be mailed to each Qualified Elector beginning February 16, 2016.

**ELECTION MATERIALS CANNOT BE FORWARDED**

All eligible registered voters will receive a ballot by mail. There will be no polling places/vote centers for this election. Replacement ballots will be available at the Yavapai County Administration Building, 10 S. 6<sup>th</sup> St. Cottonwood or the Yavapai County Administration Building, 1015 Fair St., Prescott, starting on February 10, 2016 through March 8, 2016.

**QUALIFICATIONS OF REGISTRANT**

- A. Every resident of the state is qualified to register to vote if he:
1. Is a citizen of the United States.
  2. Will be eighteen years of age or more on or before the date of the regular general election next following his registration.
  3. Will have been a resident of the state twenty-nine days next preceding the election, except as provided in section 16-126.
  4. Is able to write his name or make his mark, unless prevented from so doing by physical disability.
  5. Has not been convicted of treason or a felony, unless restored to civil rights.
  6. Has not been adjudicated an incapacitated person as defined in section 14-5101.
