Highlights Coming to the Library:

- **Through the Friends of the Library, we received grants** from ACF, Walmart, and Friends of the Verde River and affiliates totaling \$15,460 giving us partial funding to get started on a Pollinator & Learning Garden on the east side of library grounds. Work on this project includes the installation of a 10,000 gallon rainwater retention cistern will begin in January.
- After meeting with a couple of people from the City of Flagstaff, **Nicole** and ToCV Economic Development's **Crisi Clark**, are exploring ways to bring public art funding and projects to Camp Verde.
- **The Children's Library** is actively participating in the Verde Valley SciTech Festival, a branch of the [AZ SciTech Festival](#), offering free educational STEAM programs throughout the month of February. In February the **Teen Library** is starting a Teen Musicians Mechanics program focused on repairing, maintaining, and modifying instruments and collaborating with Spectrum to start a speed Cubing Club.
- **The Adult Library** is partnering with Yavapai County Community Health Services for another 8-week series of Tai Chi for Health classes starting January 17th.
