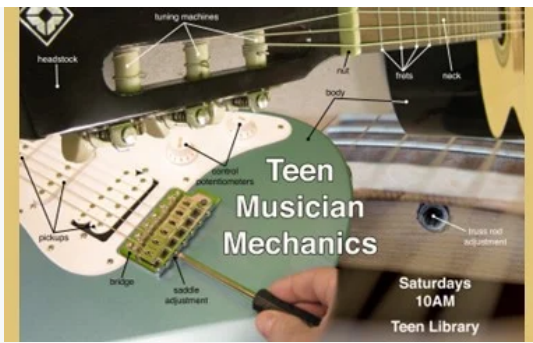

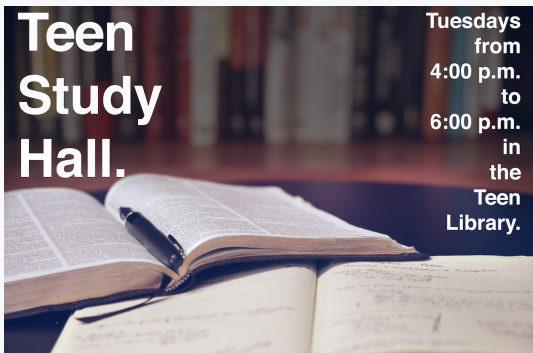

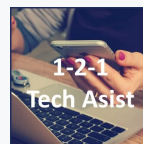

Bereavement group, facilitated by Northern AZ Hospice. Meets weekly, Fridays @9:00a in the Key Lime Room.



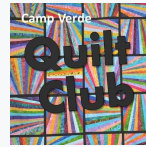
Camp Verde Stamp Club
