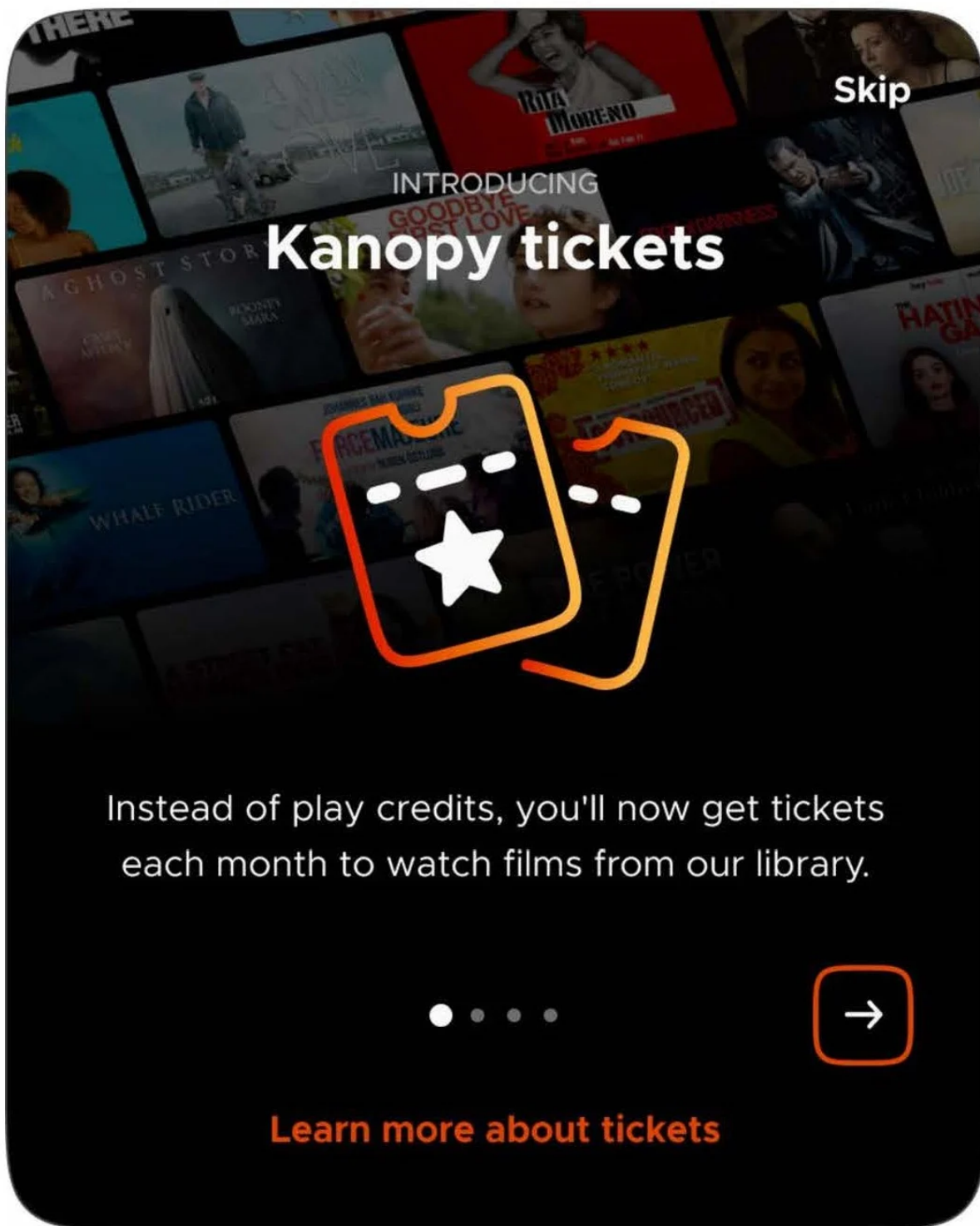
Camp Verde Community Library | Open: Monday – Saturday 9:00a - 5:00p

What is changing?

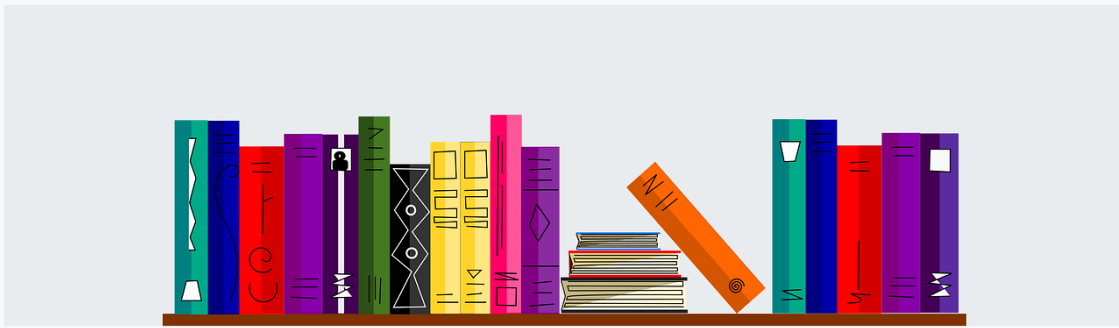
- instead of play credits, you will have a monthly ticket allotment
