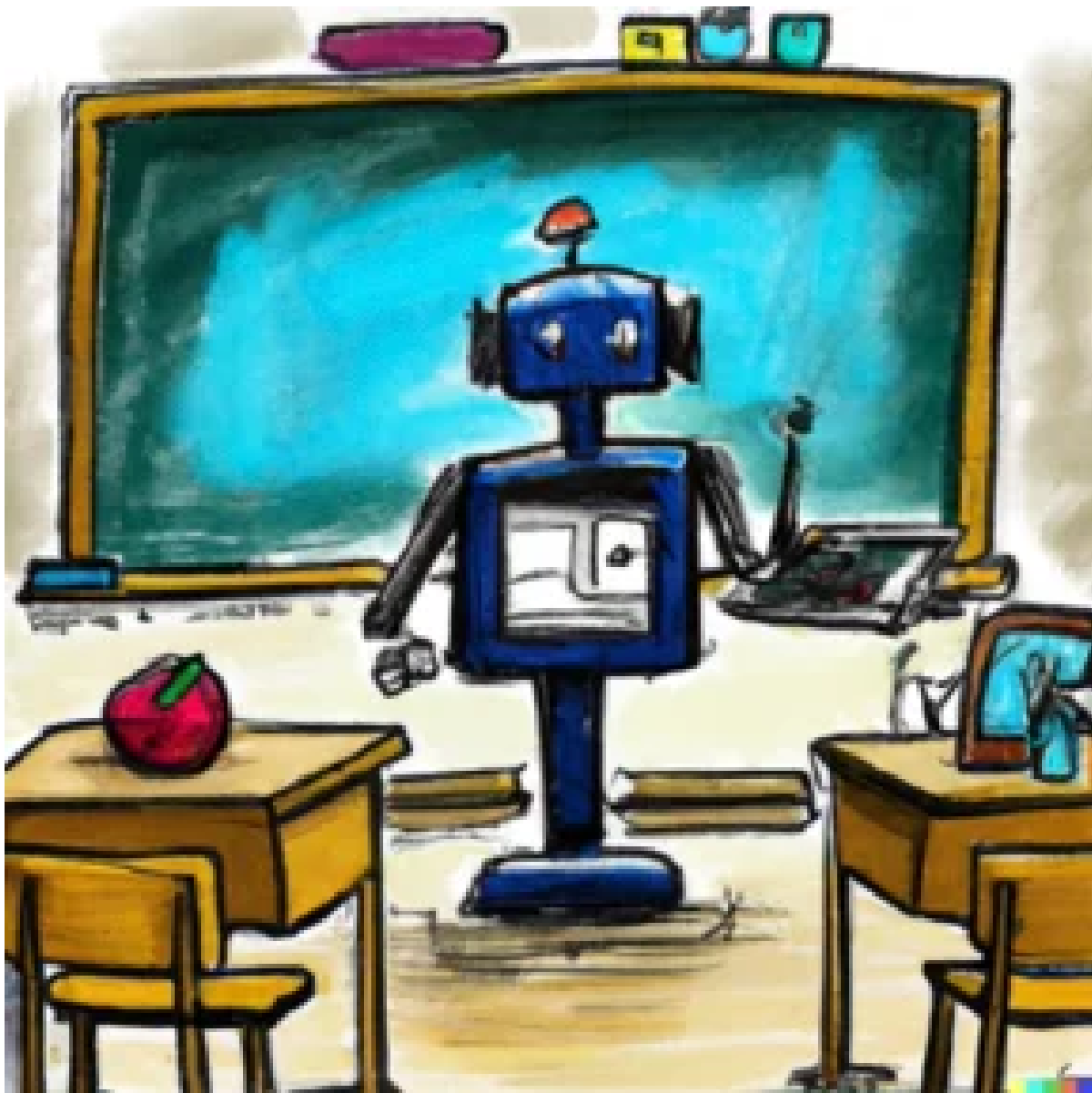
Dream Interpretation Workshop

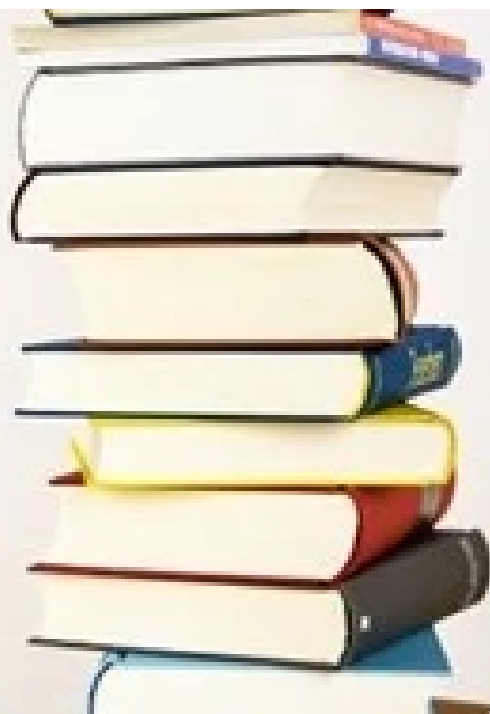

Arizona Talking Book Library

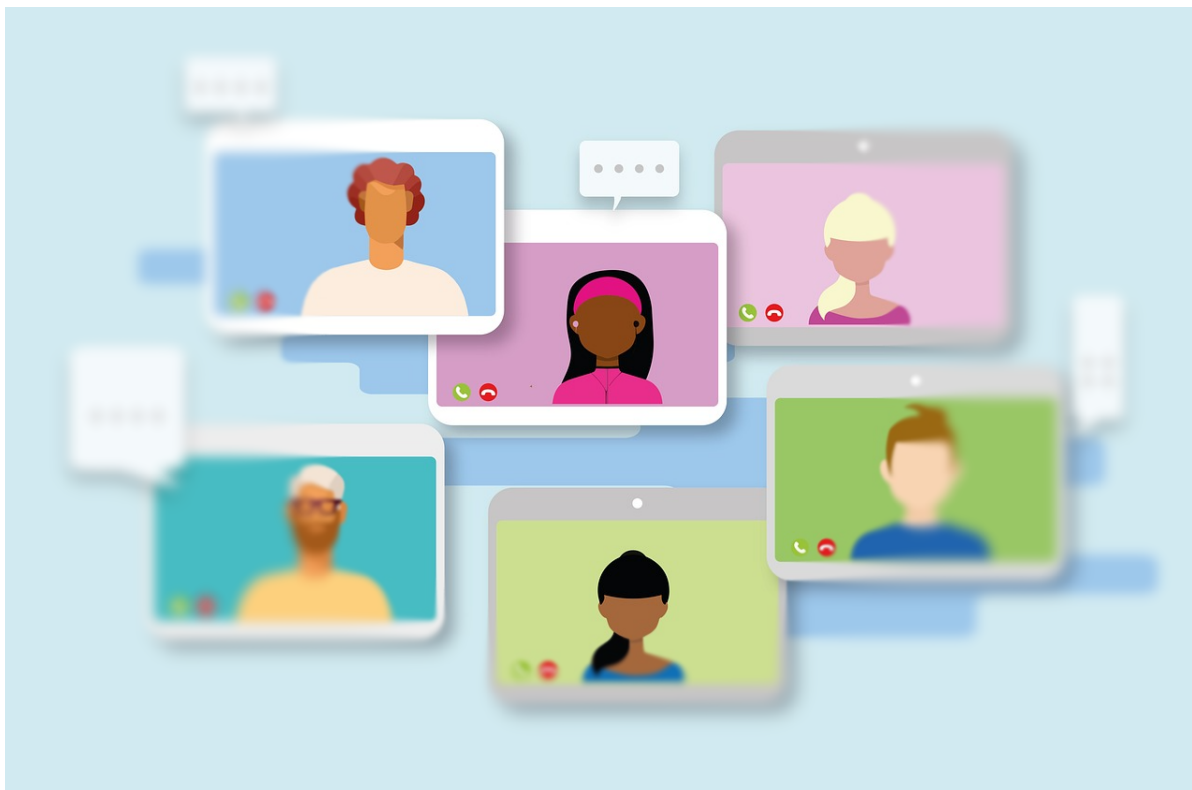
Did you know... Arizona Talking Book Library provides **free** audio book deliver and downloadable services to visually impaired, physically limited, and print disabled people throughout the state. Any person who cannot read standard print, hold a book, or turn pages is eligible for this **free** service.

All business is conducted by phone, email, fax, and USPS postal service. Talking Book Library materials, such as popular novels, magazines, local newspapers, and more, are delivered by mail to eligible clients. Each person has direct access to their own personal librarian and may receive materials, including the player and headphones, **free of charge**. The Talking Book Library is a full-service library. The difference is their "reading" materials come in audio or braille formats.

Medical and education professionals can certify the application for service. **Camp Verde Community Library provides services that support Talking Book clients.** If you need help signing up, please call us at [928-554-8380](tel:928-554-8380) and we will be happy to assist!

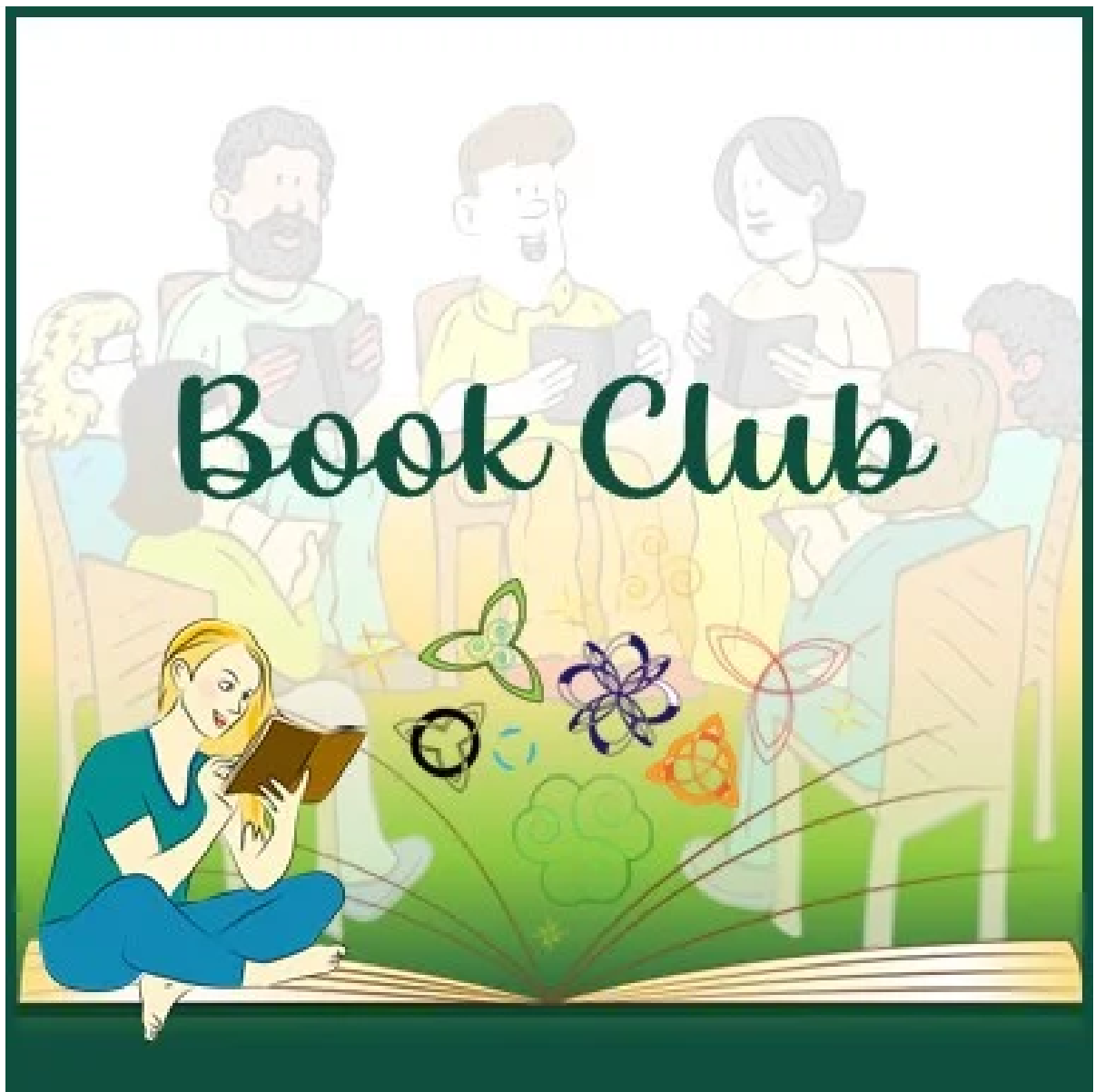

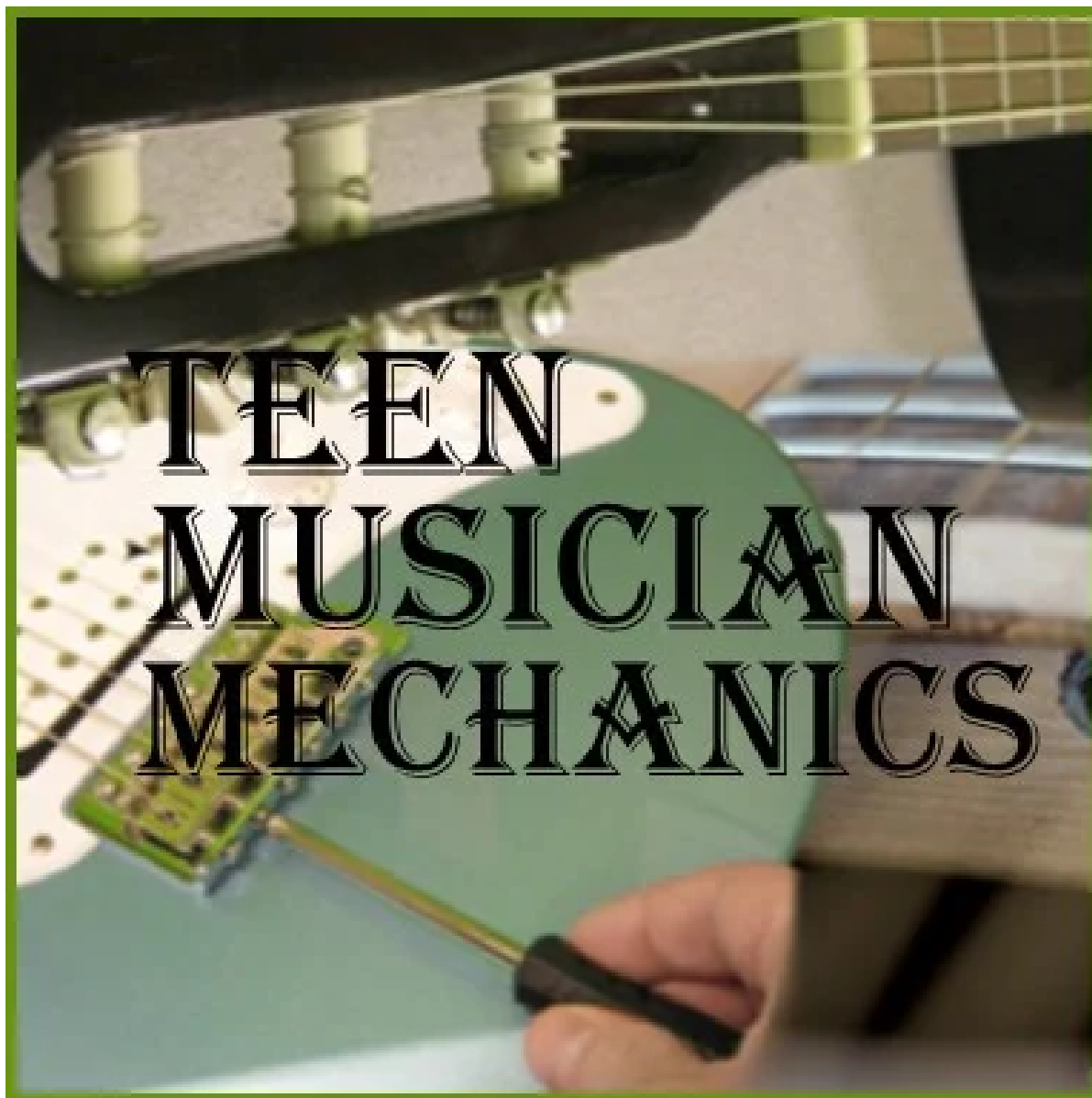
