

Ordinance 89-A36

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, AMENDING ORDINANCE 88-A27 (UNIFORM ROAD STANDARDS) BY AMENDING SECTION CV500 - RIGHT-OF WAY MINIMUM WIDTHS, CV502 - ROADWAY DESIGN STANDARDS, CV551 - ASPHALTIC CONCRETE MILLINGS AND CV790 - ROADWAY PAINT STRIPING.

BE IS ORDAINED by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Camp Verde, Yavapai County, Arizona:

- Section 1. Supersession and amendment: This ordinance supersedes and amends Ordinance 88-A27, those sections affected.
- Section 2. Reference: That certain document known as the Standard Specifications/Proposed Revisions and Additions, three (3) copies of which are on file in the office of the Town Clerk of the Town of Camp Verde, Arizona, which document was made a public record by Resolution 89-82 of the Town of Camp Verde, Arizona, is hereby referred to, adopted and made a part thereof as if fully set out in this ordinance.
- Section 3. Penalty: Any person found guilty of violating any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor, unless otherwise specified and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or by imprisonment for a period of not to exceed six (6) months, or both such fine and imprisonment. Each day that a violation continues shall be a separate offense punishable as herein above described.
- Section 4. Severability: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance adopted herein by reference, is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

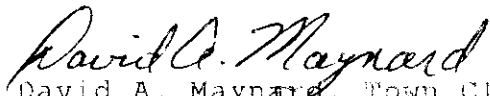
