



ORDINANCE NO. 2024-A499

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, AMENDING THE TOWN CODE CHAPTER 2 – MAYOR AND COUNCIL, ARTICLE 2-3 – MEETING PROCEDURES, SECTION 2-3-1 – REGULAR COUNCIL MEETINGS, RELATED TO CHANGING THE TIME OF THE REGULAR COUNCIL MEETINGS FROM 6:30 P.M. TO 6:00 P.M.; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council seek to establish a consistent time for Regular Council Meetings to promote clarity and predictability for the Town of Camp Verde and its residents; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council desire to change the meeting time from 6:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. to enhance community accessibility and participation in Council Meetings.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. General. The Code of Camp Verde, Arizona, Chapter 2 – Mayor and Council, Article 2-3 – Meeting Procedures, Section 2-3-1 – Regular Council Meetings is amended to read as follows (additions in ALLCAPS; deleted text in ~~strikeout~~):

Regular Council Meetings.

The Town Council will hold regular meetings at ~~6:30 p.m.~~ 6:00 P.M. on the first and third Wednesday of the month at the Council Chambers on Main Street for general business. The second and fourth Wednesday will be set aside for Work Sessions, or Special Sessions as needed. A Work Session, in lieu of or in conjunction with a Regular meeting, may be called. If a Regular meeting is cancelled, such as near a holiday, notice of the cancellation shall be posted.

Section 2. Providing for Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances. Ordinance 2019-A449 and all other ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance or any part of the Code adopted herein by reference are hereby repealed.

Section 3. Providing for Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance or any part of the Code adopted herein by reference is, for any reason, held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.
