OFFENSES

Article 10-2

Section 10-2-1 Misuse of 911 Emergency Telephone Number System


- A. Definitions. In this section unless context otherwise requires:
1. "Person" means any individual, firm, partnership, corporation, or unincorporated association.
  2. "911" means the Town of Camp Verde, Arizona's 911 Emergency telephone number system.
  3. "Emergency" means any situation in which human life or property is in jeopardy and the prompt summoning of aid is essential.

B. It is unlawful for any person to intentionally and willfully dial the 911 emergency telephone number and falsely report a non-existing emergency or to dial the 911 emergency telephone number with the intention to harass, annoy or otherwise interfere with the intended operation of the 911 emergency telephone number system.

EMERGENCY CLAUSE: It being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Town of Camp Verde, Arizona and the inhabitants thereof, and that the immediate passage of this ordinance is necessary to accomplish these purposes, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force immediately upon its passage and approval.

PASSED AND ADOPTED by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Camp Verde this 6th day of May, 1987.


