

CHAPTER 5

ORDINANCE 87-A22

JUDGES PRO TEM

Article 5-2.


Section 5-2-4:

The Town Magistrate may recommend to Council the names of individuals qualified to serve as Judges Pro Tem for the Magistrate Court, subject to the assignment and direction of the Town Magistrate, once appointed. All Judges Pro Tem shall serve for an unspecified term, subject to the removal by the Town Council or the Town Magistrate. All duly appointed Judges Pro Tem shall be compensated on an hourly basis per a fee established by the Town Council, and subject to the reimbursement of those travel expenses and other out-of-pocket allowances permitted for Town Employees. All Judges Pro Tem shall be independent contractors, and not subject to the benefits or wage provision for Town Employees.

EMERGENCY CLAUSE:

It being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Town of Camp Verde, Arizona, and the inhabitants thereof, and that the immediate passage of this Ordinance is necessary to accomplish these purposes, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force immediately upon its passage and approval.


