

ORDINANCE 87-A04

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, YAVAPAI, ARIZONA PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF WARRANTS PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF A.R.S. SEC. 42-313 AND A.R.S. SECS. 9-247 THROUGH 249 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF CAMP VERDE, ARIZONA:

Section 1: Issuance of Warrants.

That whenever the Town of Camp Verde is indebted upon an account, upon approval for payment of such indebtedness by the Common Council of the Town of Camp Verde by motion noted in the minutes of a regular or special meeting, the Mayor or the Vice Mayor, in case of his absence or unavailability, is authorized to issue warrants upon the Town treasurer for the amount due. Not more than one warrant shall be drawn for the amount allowed. The warrant shall be drawn in favor of the person to whom it is due, and the warrant shall be substantially in the following form:



Section 2. Emergency Clause.


