**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, ADOPTING "THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE DISASTER RESPONSE PLAN"**

*WHEREAS*, the Town of Camp Verde is committed to ensuring the safety of its citizenry, and


*WHEREAS*, the State of Arizona and Yavapai County Emergency Management Office support and proscribe that all municipalities have in place a form of disaster planning, and

*WHEREAS*, it would be in the best interest of the Town to adopt a set of protocols for handling man-originating or natural disasters,

***NOW THEREFORE THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE RESOLVE TO ADOPT THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE DISASTER RESPONSE PLAN:***

1. The "Town of Camp Verde Disaster Response Plan" is comprised of a series of response protocols designed to adequately coordinate logistical, administrative and public safety efforts in the event of a man-originated or natural disaster.
2. The town will pursue ongoing assessment and development of a disaster plan to ensure it maintains integrity in the face of new developments, trends or technology that threaten the community.
3. The town will pursue and support related training for key administrative and line personnel relative to disaster response and preparedness.


