**A RESOLUTION OF MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE
TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA,
TO APPLY FOR THE ARIZONA CRIMINAL JUSTICE COMMISSION,
LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT BLOCK GRANT 2002**

WHEREAS, the Town of Camp Verde, a municipal corporation ("Town") has been notified by the Arizona Criminal Justice Commission it is eligible to apply for a direct grant award in the amount of \$8,565 for increasing law enforcement resources, as well as other objectives of the grant, and

WHEREAS, the Town has been requested to apply for the funds, match the funds with a cash amount of \$857, and execute a funding agreement for the grant, and to abide by the terms thereof,

**NOW THEREFORE THE MAYOR AND THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE
TOWN OF CAMP VERDE RESOLVE TO APPLY FOR THE LOCAL LAW
ENFORCEMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDING AND AUTHORIZE THE TOWN
MANAGER TO SIGN THE GRANT APPLICATION, EXECUTE THE
AGREEMENT, AND ALLOCATE THE MATCHING FUNDS.**


