**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE
TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA
PERTAINING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A MEMORANDUM OF
UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE AND THE YAVAPAI
COUNTY VICTIM-WITNESS OFFICE**

WHEREAS, the Town of Camp Verde is aware of the surge of domestic violence cases within its boundaries, and

WHEREAS, the Town is concerned has an ongoing commitment to improve the quality of services to victims of domestic violence, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Camp Verde and the Yavapai County Victim-Witness Office have a mutual interest in mitigating the surge of domestic violence cases in Camp Verde, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Camp Verde and the Yavapai County Victim-Witness Office are mutually invested in improving the quality of services to domestic violence victims,

**NOW THEREFORE THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF
CAMP VERDE, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That the Town of Camp Verde approves the signing of the attached Memorandum of Understanding with the Yavapai County Victim-Witness Office, and thereby
 - a. Approves the submission of a joint grant application to the State of Arizona Victims of Crime Act Grant for the 2002-2004 cycle, and
 - b. Requests funding for the hire of a part-time Victim-Witness Advocate.
