



RESOLUTION 2002-504

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, OPPOSING THE PROPOSED MODIFICATIONS TO THE COMPOSITION OF THE ARIZONA STATE TRANSPORTATION BOARD

Greater Arizona, comprised of Arizona's 13 rural counties and 63 communities, supports the existing structure and composition of Arizona's State Transportation Board. The current Board is to be commended for its continuing efforts to refine and enhance the processes utilized to develop a reliable, high quality transportation system for the State of Arizona.

WHEREAS, the Town of Camp Verde supports the current structure and membership of the State Transportation Board as specified in Arizona Revised Statutes, Section 28-302; and

WHEREAS, the State Transportation Board has the sole responsibility for operations, maintenance, preservation, and improvement of the state highway system; and

WHEREAS, eighty-four percent of the State's land area is in Greater Arizona; and

WHEREAS, eighty-three percent of the state highway system route miles, and seventy-eight percent of the lane miles are located in Greater Arizona; and

WHEREAS, fifty-three percent of the daily vehicle miles of travel occur in Greater Arizona; and

WHEREAS, the membership of the State Transportation Board must be reflective of the characteristics of the state highway system for which the Board is responsible; and

WHEREAS, the existing structure of the State Transportation Board is reflective of the state highway system and provides for equitable and balanced statewide representation,

***NOW THEREFORE*, the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Camp Verde hereby resolve that the region is strongly opposed to any proposed modification to the membership and composition of the State Transportation Board which results in additional urban representation from Maricopa or Pima County.**
