



RESOLUTION 2002-519

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, ARIZONA ENDORSING THE ARIZONANS FOR FAIR GAMING AND INDIAN SELF-RELIANCE INITIATIVE

WHEREAS, The Yavapai-Apache Nation and a coalition of other Indian Nations and numerous other citizens of Arizona have proposed an initiative to place amendments to Arizona Revised Statutes concerning gaming in the State, and;

WHEREAS, The Camp Verde Town Council has an abiding interest in protecting the public health, welfare and safety by supporting appropriate regulation of gaming in the State, and;

WHEREAS, After careful consideration of the issues and the interests of all the citizens of Camp Verde the Town Council agrees with their neighbors, the Yavapai-Apache Nation, that the Arizonans for Fair Gaming and Indian Self-Reliance Initiative is the most beneficial proposal addressing gaming in Arizona at this time,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, ARIZONA AS FOLLOWS:

The Town of Camp Verde, hereby, endorses and supports the Arizonans for Fair Gaming and Indian Self-Reliance Initiative on gaming in Arizona and urges all citizens of the State to sign the initiative petition and vote in favor of this initiative.


