



**RESOLUTION 2006-707**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, STATING THE SALARY EQUIVALENCY AND THE NUMBER OF AUTHORIZED POSITIONS FOR RESERVE POLICE OFFICERS IN THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE.**

**WHEREAS**, Sections 23-901(6) (d) of the Arizona Revised Statutes provides that the governing body of a City/Town may establish a salary equivalency for workers' compensation, premium payments and compensation benefits for Volunteer Reserve Police Officers serving on full-time basis (or part-time basis) without pay.

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Camp Verde resolve, that the salary equivalent for volunteer Reserve Police Officers for the Town of Camp Verde is Two Thousand Six Hundred Twenty Eight Dollars (\$2,628.00) per month for the purposes of premium payments and compensation benefits under the workers' compensation provision of the Arizona Revised Statutes, to be effective the 18<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2006 and that the number of Reserve Police Officers eligible for coverage under the workers compensation coverage is 10 (ten).
