

RESOLUTION 2001-477

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, DECLARING AND ADOPTING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION OF THE TOWN HELD ON MAY 15, 2001.

WHEREAS, the Town of Camp Verde ("Town"), held a general election on May 15, 2001, for the nomination and/or election of one (1) Council members, and

WHEREAS, the election returns have been presented by the Yavapai County Elections Department have been canvassed by the Town Council,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Camp Verde, Yavapai County, Arizona, pursuant to A.R.S. §16-646 and 9-821.01:

1. **The total number of ballots cast at the General Election, as shown on the poll lists, were 1,808, and the total number of registered voters in the Town was 4120, for a turnout of 44.13%.**
2. **There was one ballot to be verified and one early ballot. Two voters were found to be ineligible and two ballots rejected.**
