A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION TO TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM


WHEREAS, the Town of Camp Verde supports and encourages the use of Transportation Enhancement Program funds to design and build a multi-use pathway in an effort to improve safety conditions along Montezuma Castle Highway between Apache Trail at the site of the Camp Verde Unified School District Complex (Complex) and the Yavapai-Apache Nation boundary line; and

WHEREAS, construction of a multi-use pathway along this major corridor would provide a link to bike/pedestrian lanes in and around the Complex, nearby trails and the various recreational facilities consisted with the town's General Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Camp Verde agree to abide by the guidelines set forth by the program sponsor, Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT), and hereby commit to a matching fund amount not to exceed \$80,000 in the event of a grant award, which is greater than the required 5.7% cash match for the maximum grant award amount of \$500,000 as set forth in the notice of funding availability.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Camp Verde to authorize staff to submit application to the Transportation Enhancement Program in the amount of \$500,000, and that expenses related to the design and engineering of the project which will be the responsibility of the Town.
