WHEREAS, the draft Governance Committee recommendations create an additional level of government and fail to achieve the committee's identified goals.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the TOWN OF CAMP VERDE that the Town is strongly opposed to the draft recommendations of the Governance Committee which suggest the modification of the State Transportation Board composition, and the creation of new transportation districts and their respective elected boards.
